

A dental emergency can happen without warning, and knowing what to do first can help protect the tooth and reduce discomfort until you are seen. [Dental emergency Cambridge](#) visits often start with a focused exam and imaging when needed to find the cause of pain and decide what treatment is most appropriate. For those patients, Sedation dentist Cambridge options may help make treatment feel calmer and more manageable. Depending on the situation, we can discuss comfort choices such as nitrous oxide or other sedation options when appropriate, along with numbing and gentle techniques. In addition to emergency visits, staying current with routine exams can help catch small issues before they become urgent.
